## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, with respect to the revocation or suspension of drivers' licenses of individuals convicted of drug offenses, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Better Drive Act".

1 **SEC. 2. REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF DRIVERS' LI-**  
2 **CENSES OF INDIVIDUALS CONVICTED OF**  
3 **DRUG OFFENSES.**

4 Section 159 of title 23, United States Code, and the  
5 item relating to that section in the analysis for chapter  
6 1 of such title, are repealed.
