### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

# 1SEC. 2. UPDATING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL2STRATEGY FOR PANDEMIC INFLUENZA.

3 (a) UPDATE OF NATIONAL STRATEGY.—Not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, 4 5 the Homeland Security Council of the White House and the National Security Council, in consultation with the 6 7 heads of appropriate Federal departments and agencies 8 responsible for biodefense, shall update the National 9 Strategy for Pandemic Influenza issued by the Homeland Security Council in November 2005. 10

(b) UPDATE OF IMPLEMENTATION PLAN.—Not later
than 180 days after the update of the 2005 National
Strategy for Pandemic Influenza required under subsection (a), the Homeland Security Council and the National Security Council shall update the implementation
plan associated with the 2005 National Strategy to implement such updated National Strategy.
