## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the Civil Air Patrol for their service to the citizens of Georgia; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol was founded on December 1, 1941, as an organization of
- 4 volunteers meant to assist the United States military in national defense by performing aerial
- 5 coastal patrols and emergency services within the continental United States; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in 1943, the capabilities of this new volunteer organization were recognized as
- 7 vital to national defense, and by Presidential Executive Order, the Civil Air Patrol was
- 8 assigned to the War Department and then designated official auxiliary to the United States
- 9 Air Force to perform emergency services, aerospace education, and cadet programs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Civil Air Patrol air and ground teams perform over 90 percent of inland search
- and rescue missions tasked by the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center with its 58,000
- 12 volunteers and 560 aircrafts; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol is celebrating its 70 year association with the United States
- 14 Air Force in performing these "Missions for America" as part of the United States Air Force's
- 15 Total Force, joining the ranks of the regular Air Force, Air National Guard, Air Force
- 16 Reserve, and Air Force retired military and civilian employees; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the Georgia Wing of the Civil Air Patrol consists of nearly 1,900 volunteer
- 18 members in 43 squadrons and six groups located throughout this state, which were awarded
- 19 the National Squadron of Distinction in both 2008 and 2009; the Southeast Region Squadron
- 20 of Distinction in 2010; numerous other honors for counter drug, emergency services, and
- 21 cadet programs; and a National Commander's Citation for its support of Deep Water
- 22 Horizon; and

23 WHEREAS, Georgia Wing members volunteer their time, services, and resources to actively

- 24 support the Civil Air Patrol by conducting missions in homeland security, disaster relief and
- 25 emergency services, search and rescue, counter drug, aerospace education, and cadet
- 26 programs; and
- 27 WHEREAS, these efforts were exhibited by their relief efforts for the victims of Hurricane
- 28 Harvey, Irma, and Maria; in supporting the Governor's Task Force for Drug Suppression; and
- 29 by honoring more than 15,000 of Georgia's fallen soldiers through the Wreaths Across
- 30 America initiative; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the estimated value of the Georgia Wing members' volunteer hours in 2017 was
- 32 almost \$5.7 million; and
- 33 WHEREAS, these "flying minutemen" of the Civil Air Patrol have, since its inception,
- 34 consistently provided this state with invaluable emergency services, aerospace education, and
- 35 cadet programs; and
- 36 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the dedication and efforts of these brave
- 37 volunteers be appropriately recognized.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 39 recognize the selfless contributions that the volunteers of the Civil Air Patrol have made to
- 40 the State of Georgia.
- 41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 42 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the Georgia Wing
- 43 of the Civil Air Patrol.
