# A BILL

To provide loans to employees of the Federal Government

and the government of the District of Columbia affected by a Government shutdown, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Immediate Financial
- 5 Relief for Federal Employees Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. INTEREST-FREE LOAN FOR FEDERAL AND DC EM-
- 7 PLOYEES AFFECTED BY GOVERNMENT SHUT-
- 8 DOWNS.
- 9 (a) In General.—The Secretary of the Treasury
- 10 shall, at the request of any employee affected by a Govern-
- 11 ment shutdown, issue to such employee an interest-free
- 12 loan.
- 13 (b) Notice to Employer.—At the time any loan
- 14 is provided to an employee affected by a Government shut-
- 15 down under subsection (a), the Secretary shall notify the
- 16 employee's employer that such loan has been provided and
- 17 the amount of such loan.
- 18 (c) Loan Terms.—
- 19 (1) Prohibition on fees and interest.—
- The Secretary may not charge any fee or interest in
- 21 connection with a loan provided under subsection
- 22 (a).

- 1 (2) LIMITATION ON LOAN AMOUNT.—A loan 2 provided under subsection (a) may not exceed 3 \$6,000.
  - (3) EMPLOYEES LIMITED TO ONE LOAN.—With respect to each period of time that an individual is an employee affected by a Government shutdown, the individual may not be provided more than one loan under subsection (a).

### (d) Loan Repayment.—

- (1) Repayment through garnishment.— With respect to an individual who was provided a loan under subsection (a), when such individual is no longer an employee affected by a Government shutdown, the employer of the individual shall garnish 100 percent of the individual's pay with respect to the applicable pay period, and transfer such amounts to the Secretary as repayment on the loan provided to the individual under subsection (a), until the loan is repaid in full.
- (2) Additional Repayment.—The Secretary shall issue regulations to provide for a repayment process for loans provided under subsection (a) with respect to which the garnishment requirement under paragraph (1) will not provide for the full repayment of the loan.

1	(e) Clarification.—Any loan provided under sub-
2	section (a) shall not—
3	(1) be treated as basic pay or annual pay of an
4	employee for purposes of title 5, United States Code;
5	or
6	(2) be counted for purposes of determining the
7	amount of backpay owed to such employee under the
8	Government Employee Fair Treatment Act of 2019
9	or any other provision of law.
10	(f) AUTHORITY TO MAKE LOANS AND PAY FOR AD-
11	MINISTRATIVE COSTS.—There are hereby made available
12	to the Secretary from amounts in the general fund of the
13	Treasury not otherwise appropriated, such sums as may
14	be necessary to provide the loans described under sub-
15	section (a) and to pay for the administrative costs of car-
16	rying out this section.
17	(g) Definitions.—For purposes of this section:
18	(1) Employee affected by a government
19	SHUTDOWN.—The term "employee affected by a
20	Government shutdown' means—
21	(A) any employee of a Federal agency with
22	respect to which appropriations have lapsed for
23	a period equal to or longer than 15 consecutive
24	days beginning on or after December 22, 2018;
25	and

1	(B) any employee of an office of the gov-
2	ernment of the District of Columbia with re-
3	spect to which appropriations have so lapsed.
4	(2) Employer.—With respect to an individual

- (2) EMPLOYER.—With respect to an individual who is provided a loan under subsection (a), the term "employer" means the Federal agency or office of the government of the District of Columbia that employs such individual on the date the individual became an employee affected by a Government shutdown.
- (3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Treasury.

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
