A BILL

To prohibit the Corporation for National and Community Service from removing State offices of the Corporation from States without Congressional approval.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keep Community Serv-
5 ice Local Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL FOR CLOSURE OF**
2 **STATE CNCS OFFICES UNDER CERTAIN CIR-**
3 **CUMSTANCES.**

4 Section 196A(a) of the National and Community
5 Service Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12651h) is amended by
6 adding at the end the following:

7 “(c) LIMITATION ON CLOSURE OF STATE OF-
8 FICES.—The Corporation may not close a State office re-
9 quired under subsection (a), where such closure results in
10 there being no office in such State, unless permitted or
11 directed to do so by an Act of Congress.”.
