SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Investors' 5 Personally Identifiable Information Act". SEC. 2. PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION EX-6 7 CLUDED FROM CONSOLIDATED AUDIT TRAIL 8 **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.** 9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Securities and Exchange Com-10 mission may not require a national securities exchange, a 11 national securities association, or a member of such an exchange or association to provide personally identifiable in-12 formation with respect to a market participant to meet the 13 requirements relating to an order or a reportable event 14 15 under section 242.613(c)(7) of title 17, Code of Federal Reg-

16 ulations (or successor regulations).

17 (b) DEFINITION OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE IN18 FORMATION.—In this section, the term "personally identifi19 able information"—

(1) means information that can be used to distinguish or trace an individual's identity, either
alone or when combined with other personal or identifying information that is linked or linkable to a specific individual, including an individual's name, ad-

1	dress, date or year of birth, Social Security number,
2	telephone number, email, and IP-address; and
3	(2) does not include a CAT-Order-ID or CAT-
4	Reporter-ID, as such terms are defined in section
5	242.613(j) of title 17, Code of Federal Regulations (or
6	successor regulations).
