- 3 WHEREAS, service to others is a hallmark of the American character and central to how we

- 19 WHEREAS, national service represents a unique public-private partnership that invests in
- 20 community solutions and leverages nonfederal resources to strengthen community impact
- 21 and increase the return on taxpayer dollars; and

- 27 Inc., (YELLS) program where AmeriCorps VISTA members build capacity to educate and
