## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, so as to require
- 3 the bureau to publicly post and share certain information from the Law Enforcement
- 4 Notification System of the Enforcement Integrated Database of the United States Department
- 5 of Homeland Security to the extent permitted by federal law; to provide for related matters;
- 6 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 general provisions regarding the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, is amended by adding a
- 11 new Code section to read as follows:
- 12 <u>"35-3-14.</u>
- 13 To the extent permitted by federal law, the bureau shall post on its public website the
- information of persons who are aliens and who have been released from federal custody
- within the boundaries of this state, as such information is presented within the Law
- 16 <u>Enforcement Notification System of the Enforcement Integrated Database of the United</u>
- 17 <u>States Department of Homeland Security or the National Law Enforcement</u>
- 18 <u>Telecommunications System as received by the Georgia Information Sharing and Analysis</u>
- 19 <u>Center within the bureau or any replacement agency. Within 12 hours of receiving such</u>
- 20 <u>information, the bureau shall post such information as required by this Code section and</u>
- 21 <u>electronically send a copy of such information to the Georgia Sheriffs' Association. The</u>
- 22 <u>bureau shall promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation of this Code section."</u>

SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
