 - **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ryan Kules Specially
 - 5 Adaptive Housing Improvement Act of 2019".

1SEC. 2. PRIORITY IN AWARD OF SPECIALLY ADAPTED2HOUSING GRANTS TO SERIOUSLY ILL VET-3ERANS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2101 of title 38, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol6 lowing new subsection:

7 "(d) PRIORITY FOR SERIOUSLY ILL VETERANS.—(1)
8 In providing assistance under this section, the Secretary
9 shall give priority to seriously ill veterans.

10 "(2) In this section, the term 'seriously ill veteran'
11 shall have the meaning given such term by the Sec12 retary.".

13 (b) DEFINITION OF SERIOUSLY ILL VETERAN.—

14 (1) IN GENERAL.—By not later than 90 days
15 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec16 retary of Veterans Affairs shall—

17 (A) determine the meaning of the term
18 "seriously ill veteran" for purposes of sub19 section (d) of section 2101 of title 38, United
20 States Code, as added by subsection (a); and

(B) submit to the Committees on Veterans'
Affairs of the Senate and House of Representatives the meaning of such term as so determined.

25 (2) APPLICABILITY.—The definition of "seri26 ously ill veteran" as determined under paragraph (1)
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shall apply for purposes of such subsection (d) be ginning on the date that is 30 days after the date
 on which the Secretary submits to the Committees
 on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of
 Representatives the definition of such term as so de termined.

7 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2020, and
9 apply with respect to assistance provided on or after that
10 date.

11 SEC. 3. INCREASE IN AMOUNTS OF ASSISTANCE PROVIDED.

(a) INCREASE OF NUMBER OF GRANTS PER VET13 ERAN.—Section 2102(d)(3) of such title is amended by
14 striking "three" and inserting "six".

(b) INCREASE IN NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS AUTHORIZED TO BE APPROVED.—Section 2101(a)(4) of
such title is amended by striking "30 applications" and
inserting "120 applications".

(c) INCREASE IN MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE
FOR ADAPTATION TO VETERAN'S RESIDENCE.—Section
2102(b)(2) of such title is amended by striking "\$12,000"
and inserting "\$19,733".

23 (d) INCREASE IN AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF ASSIST-24 ANCE FOR ACQUISITION OF HOUSING WITH SPECIAL

FEATURES.—Section 2102(d)(1) of such title is amended
 by striking "\$63,780" and inserting "\$98,492".

3 (e) INCREASE IN AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF ASSIST4 ANCE FOR ADAPTATIONS TO VETERANS' RESIDENCES.—
5 Section 2102(d)(2) of such title is amended by striking
6 "\$12,756" and inserting "\$19,733".

7 (f) EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION.—The 8 amendments made by this section shall take effect on Oc-9 tober 1, 2020. The amendments made by subsections (c) 10 and (d) shall apply with respect to individuals who have 11 not received the maximum amount of assistance under 12 section 2101 of title 38, United States Code, before such 13 date.

14 SEC. 4. PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS OF SPE15 CIALLY ADAPTED HOUSING ASSISTANCE FOR
16 CERTAIN VETERANS.

17 Section 2102 of such title is amended by adding at18 the end the following new subsection:

19 "(f)(1) Notwithstanding the aggregate amounts spec-20 ified in subsection (d), a covered veteran may apply for 21 and receive an additional amount of assistance under sub-22 section (a) or (b) of section 2101 of this title in an amount 23 that does not exceed half of the amount specified in sub-24 section (d).
