FOR the purpose of clarifying certain provisions of law pertaining to a certain

State Retirement and Pension System that are reemployed in certain positions; and

30 (c) (2) (i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph and 31 subject to [subparagraph (iii)] SUBPARAGRAPHS (III) AND (IV) of this paragraph, the 32 reduction required under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall equal:

1. the amount by which the sum of the individual's initial
 annual basic allowance and the individual's annual compensation exceeds the average final
 compensation used to compute the basic allowance; or

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1 2. for a retiree who retired under the Workforce Reduction 2 Act (Chapter 353 of the Acts of 1996), the amount by which the sum of the retiree's annual 3 compensation and the retiree's annual basic allowance at the time of retirement, including 4 the incentive provided by the Workforce Reduction Act, exceeds the average final 5 compensation used to compute the basic allowance.

(c) (4) (i) Any reduction taken to an allowance under paragraph (3) of this
 subsection may not [reduce the allowance to less than the amount required to be deducted]
 REDUCE THE ALLOWANCE TO AN AMOUNT LESS THAN THE REQUIRED DEDUCTION for the individual's monthly State–approved medical insurance premiums.

AMOUNT LESS THAN THE REQUIRED DEDUCTION for the retiree's monthly
State-approved medical insurance premiums.

(2) [If a reduction for a calendar year taken under paragraph (1) of this
subsection is less than the reduction required under subsection (c) of this section, the] THE
Board of Trustees shall recover from the retiree [an amount equal to] ANY DIFFERENCE
BETWEEN the reduction required under subsection (c) of this section less the reduction
taken under paragraph (1) of this subsection.
