A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act prohibiting abortion after detection of fetal cardiac activity or fetal heart
- 2 contractions."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 18.16 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 18.16.055. Abortion after fetal heartbeat detected. (a) Notwithstanding compliance with AS 18.16.010, a person may not knowingly perform an abortion after a health care provider detects a fetal heartbeat unless the abortion is medically necessary.
- 9 (b) The provisions of (a) of this section do not apply to a woman on whom an abortion is performed.
- 11 (c) Violation of (a) of this section is a class C felony.
- 12 (d) In this section,
- 13 (1) "fetal heartbeat" means cardiac activity or the steady and repetitive 14 rhythmic contraction of the fetal heart within the gestational sac;

1 (2) "health care provider" means a person who is licensed, registered, 2 or otherwise authorized under AS 08 to provide health care services.
