SUBJECT: FY 2020 Reprogramming Request: \$ 11,384,722.00 within the Department of Parks and Recreation

Dear Chairman Mendelson:

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 47-363(a), I am transmitting the enclosed request to reprogram \$ 11,384,722.00 of Fiscal Year 2020 Local Funds budget within the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR).

This emergency, the "Department of Parks and Recreation Reprogramming Emergency Approval Act of 2020" and accompanying emergency declaration resolution are necessary to support the reclassification of Local funds expenses within various personal and nonpersonal services budget categories, which is required because of a projected revenue shortfall in one of DPR's Special Purpose Revenue funds. Budget is available in Local funds because of the agency's projected curtailment of expenditures in the specified categories.

I urge the Council to take prompt and favorable action on this measure.

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, the reprogramming request of Fiscal Year 2020 local funds in the amount of \$11,384,722 within the Department of Parks and Recreation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Department of Parks and Recreation Reprogramming Emergency Approval Act of 2020".

Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to section 47-363 of the District of Columbia Official Code, the Mayor transmitted to the Council a reprogramming request in the amount of \$11,384,722 within the Department of Parks and Recreation.

(b) The Council approves the \$11,384,722 reprogramming request.

Sec. 3. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override that veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)) .
