To amend title IV of the Public Health Service Act to prohibit sale or transactions relating to human fetal tissue.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

## 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Prohibiting the Life5 Ending Industry of Fetal Organ Exchange Act" or the 6 "Pro-LIFE Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITING SALE OR TRANSACTIONS RELATING TO HUMAN FETAL TISSUE.

Section 498B(e) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. $298 \mathrm{~g}-2(\mathrm{e})$ ) is amended by striking paragraph (3) and inserting the following new paragraph:
"(3) The term 'valuable consideration’ in-cludes-
"(A) any payment made or debt incurred;
"(B) any gift, honorarium, or recognition of value bestowed;
"(C) any price, charge, or fee which is waived, forgiven, reduced, or indefinitely delayed,
"(D) any loan or debt which is canceled or otherwise forgiven;
"(E) the transfer of any item from one person to another or provision of any service or granting of any opportunity for which a charge is customarily made, without charge or for a reduced charge; and
"(F) any payments associated with the transportation, implantation, processing, preservation, quality control, or storage of human fetal tissue.".
