 (2) if the Secretary of State determines that

the Muslim Brotherhood does not meet the criteria
referred to in paragraph (1), includes a detailed justification as to which criteria have not been met.

9 (c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (b)
10 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
11 a classified annex, if appropriate.

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
