A BILL

To direct the President to withdraw from the International Joint Commission immunity from suit and other forms of judicial process.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "IJC Accountability
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL FROM THE INTERNATIONAL JOINT
- 7 COMMISSION OF IMMUNITY FROM SUIT AND
- 8 OTHER FORMS OF JUDICIAL PROCESS.
- 9 (a) In General.—The President shall, on the day
- 10 after the date of the enactment of this Act and pursuant

- 1 to section 1 of the International Organizations Immunities
- 2 Act (22 U.S.C. 288), withdraw from the International
- 3 Joint Commission, its property and its assets, wherever
- 4 located, and by whomever held, immunity from suit and
- 5 other forms of judicial process as provided for under sec-
- 6 tion 2(b) of such Act (22 U.S.C. 288a(b)).
- 7 (b) Applicability.—The withdrawal of immunity
- 8 described in subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any
- 9 suit or other forms of judicial process against or relating
- 10 to the International Joint Commission initiated on or after
- 11 December 1, 2016.
