16 (b) (1) To provide a fund to pay the expense of protecting and managing 17 wildlife, and preventing unauthorized persons from hunting them, a person may not hunt 18 or attempt to hunt during open season and in any permitted manner any game birds and 19 mammals in the State without first having procured either a resident or nonresident 20 hunter's license.
