

(B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO VETERANS SUFFERING FROM POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER, ANXIETY, DEPRESSION, OR STRESS SEEKING RELIEF THROUGH AND NEEDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO OBTAIN COMPLEMENTARY AND ALTERNATIVE MEDICAL TREATMENTS.

- 1 (C) THE TRUST SHALL IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM IN 2 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- 3 (D) THE TRUST SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE FUND UNDER § 9–913 OF 4 THIS SUBTITLE TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR THE PROGRAM.
- 5 (E) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 6 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING:
