A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Law – Package Theft**
3 **(Defense Against Porch Pirates Act)**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from knowingly or willfully obtaining or exerting
5 control that is unauthorized over a package delivered to another with the intent to
6 deprive the owner of the package; establishing certain penalties for a violation of this
7 Act; and generally relating to theft and package deliveries.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Criminal Law**

16 **7–106.1.**

17 **(A) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY OR WILLFULLY OBTAIN OR EXERT**
18 **CONTROL THAT IS UNAUTHORIZED OVER A PACKAGE DELIVERED TO ANOTHER WITH**
19 **THE INTENT TO DEPRIVE THE OWNER OF THE PACKAGE.**

20 **(B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND**
21 **ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE**
22 **NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.**
