Mr. MORELLE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 729) to amend the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 to authorize grants to Indian Tribes to further achievement of Tribal coastal zone objectives, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That any time after adoption of this resolu-
2 tion the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 729) to amend the Coastal Zone

1 Management Act of 1972 to authorize grants to Indian
2 Tribes to further achievement of Tribal coastal zone objec-
3 tives, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill
4 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
5 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
6 fined to the bill and amendments specified in this section
7 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
8 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
9 Committee on Natural Resources. After general debate the
10 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
11 minute rule. An amendment in the nature of a substitute
12 consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 116–40
13 shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the
14 Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall be
15 considered as the original bill for the purpose of further
16 amendment under the five-minute rule and shall be consid-
17 ered as read. All points of order against provisions in the
18 bill, as amended, are waived.

19 SEC. 2. (a) No further amendment to the bill, as
20 amended, shall be in order except those printed in the re-
21 port of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolu-
22 tion and amendments en bloc described in section 3 of this
23 resolution.

24 (b) Each further amendment printed in the report of
25 the Committee on Rules shall be considered only in the

1 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-
2 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,
3 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report
4 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
5 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
6 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
7 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.

8 (c) All points of order against the further amend-
9 ments printed in the report of the Committee on Rules
10 or amendments en bloc described in section 3 of this reso-
11 lution are waived.

12 SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time for the chair
13 of the Committee on Natural Resources or his designee
14 to offer amendments en bloc consisting of amendments
15 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
16 panying this resolution not earlier disposed of. Amend-
17 ments en bloc offered pursuant to this section shall be con-
18 sidered as read, shall be debatable for 20 minutes equally
19 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
20 member of the Committee on Natural Resources or their
21 designees, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
22 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
23 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.

24 SEC. 4. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
25 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the

1 bill to the House with such further amendments as may
2 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
3 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
4 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
5 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
