A BILL

To enact section 4510.023 of the Revised Code to
require a court to grant limited driving
privileges to a person in relation to a driver's
license suspension under certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4510.023 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 4510.023. Any time that a court elects to or is
required to impose a suspension of a driver's license,
commercial driver's license, temporary instruction permit,
probationary license, or nonresident operating privilege for a
criminal offense, the court shall grant limited driving
privileges under section 4510.021 of the Revised Code for the
purposes specified in division (A) of that section if both of
the following apply:

(A) No element of the offense for which the suspension is
being imposed relates to the operation or physical control of a

<u>motor vehicle or to the failure to comply with a requirement for</u>	17
<u>the use, possession, or registration of a motor vehicle.</u>	18
<u>(B) The suspension is not required to be imposed due to</u>	19
<u>the involvement of a motor vehicle in the offense or the failure</u>	20
<u>to obtain a valid license or permit for the operation of a motor</u>	21
<u>vehicle.</u>	22
