A BILL

To authorize the Marshal of the Supreme Court and the Supreme Court Police to protect the Justices, employees, and official guests of the Supreme Court outside of the Supreme Court grounds, and for other purposes.

 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reauthorizing Security
 5 for Supreme Court Justices Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION AUTHORITY OF MARSHAL OF THE SU-**
 7 **PREME COURT AND SUPREME COURT PO-**
 8 **LICE.**

9 Section 6121 of title 40, United States Code, is
 10 amended—

11 (1) in subsection (a)—

12 (A) in paragraph (2), in the matter pre-
 13 ceding subparagraph (A), by striking “any
 14 State” and inserting “any location”; and

15 (B) in paragraph (3)—

16 (i) by striking “violation of federal or
 17 state law” and inserting “violation of Fed-
 18 eral or State law”; and

19 (ii) by striking “regulation under fed-
 20 eral or state law” and inserting “regula-
 21 tion under Federal or State law”; and

22 (2) in subsection (b)—

23 (A) by striking paragraph (2);

24 (B) by striking “ADDITIONAL REQUIRE-
 25 MENTS” and all that follows through “Duties

1 under” and inserting “AUTHORIZATION To
2 CARRY FIREARMS—Duties under”; and
3 (C) by striking “any State” and inserting
4 “any location”.
