A BILL

- To provide for the inclusion on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall of the names of the soldiers who died on Flying Tiger Flight 739 on March 16, 1962.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Flying Tiger Flight

5 739 Act".

SEC. 2. INCLUSION ON THE VIETNAM VETERANS MEMO RIAL WALL OF THE NAMES OF THE SOLDIERS WHO DIED ON FLYING TIGER FLIGHT 739 ON MARCH 16, 1962.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than one year after the 6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense 7 shall authorize the inclusion on the Vietnam Veterans Me-8 morial Wall in the District of Columbia of the names of 9 the 93 soldiers who died on Flying Tiger Flight 739 when 10 it crashed in the Pacific Ocean en route to Vietnam on 11 March 16, 1962.

12 (b) REQUIRED CONSULTATION.—The Secretary of 13 Defense shall consult with the Secretary of the Interior, the American Battle Monuments Commission, and other 14 applicable authorities with respect to any adjustments to 15 the nomenclature and placement of names pursuant to 16 subsection (a) to address any space limitations on the 17 18 placement of additional names on the Vietnam Veterans 19 Memorial Wall.

(c) NONAPPLICABILITY OF COMMEMORATIVE WORKS
ACT.—Chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly known as the "Commemorative Works Act"), shall
not apply to any activities carried out under subsection
(a) or (b).
