## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 37 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mental health, so
- 2 as to authorize marriage and family therapists to perform certain acts which physicians,
- 3 psychologists, and others are authorized to perform regarding emergency examinations of
- 4 persons for involuntary evaluation and treatment for mental illness or alcohol or drug abuse;
- 5 to define certain terms; to provide for related matters; to provide for multiple effective dates;
- 6 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1-1.** 

- 10 Title 37 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mental health, is amended by
- 11 revising subsection (d) of Code Section 37-3-41, relating to emergency admission of a person
- 12 for involuntary evaluation of mental illness, as follows:
- 13 "(d) Any psychologist, clinical social worker, licensed professional counselor, marriage
- and family therapist, or clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health may perform
- any act specified by this Code section to be performed by a physician. Any reference in
- any part of this chapter to a physician acting under this Code section shall be deemed to refer equally to a psychologist, a clinical social worker, a licensed professional counselor,
- marriage and family therapist, or a clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health
- acting under this Code section. For purposes of this Code section, the term 'psychologist'
- 20 means any person authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a licensed
- 21 psychologist; the term 'clinical social worker' means any person authorized under the laws
- of this state to practice as a licensed clinical social worker; the term 'licensed professional
- counselor' means any person authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a licensed
- professional counselor; the term 'marriage and family therapist' means any person
- 25 <u>authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a licensed marriage and family</u>

**SECTION 1-2.** 

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Said title is further amended by revising subsection (d) of Code Section 37-7-41, relating to emergency involuntary treatment of an alcoholic, a drug abuser, or a drug dependent individual, as follows:

"(d) Any psychologist, clinical social worker, licensed professional counselor, marriage and family therapist, or clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health may perform any act specified by this Code section to be performed by a physician. Any reference in any part of this chapter to a physician acting under this Code section shall be deemed to refer equally to a psychologist, a clinical social worker, a licensed professional counselor, marriage and family therapist, or a clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health acting under this Code section. For purposes of this Code section, the term 'psychologist' means any person authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a licensed psychologist; the term 'clinical social worker' means any person authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a licensed clinical social worker; the term 'licensed professional counselor' means any person authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a licensed professional counselor; the term 'marriage and family therapist' means any person authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a licensed marriage and family therapist; and the term 'clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health' means any person authorized under the laws of this state to practice as a registered professional nurse and who is recognized by the Georgia Board of Nursing to be engaged in advanced nursing practice as a clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health."

effective on July 1, 2018, as follows:

"(d) Any psychologist, clinical social worker, marriage and family therapist, or clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health may perform any act specified by this Code section to be performed by a physician. Any reference in any part of this chapter to a physician acting under this Code section shall be deemed to refer equally to a psychologist, a clinical social worker, marriage and family therapist, or a clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health acting under this Code section.
