18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 377, is
L 9	amended to read as follows:
20	Section 377. The board of county commissioners of any county
21	may employ $\frac{1}{2}$ competent information technology (IT) staff and $\frac{1}{2}$ data
22	processing technician, who shall perform the duties of IT management
23	$\underline{\text{or}}$ data processing management as prescribed and directed by the
24	board of county commissioners, and such data processing technician

1	shall not be employed beyond the term of office of the board of
2	county commissioners employing him. The said IT staff and data
3	processing technician shall receive as compensation a salary
4	salaries to be fixed by the board of county commissioners for his
5	$\frac{ ext{their}}{ ext{services}}$, to be paid out of the general operating fund of the
6	county. The compensations of the director and such personnel <u>IT</u>
7	staff and data processing technician shall not be governed by the
8	"Comprehensive Salary Code".
9	The <u>IT staff and</u> data processing technician shall be covered by
10	the county blanket bond.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
