## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 28, 2017, as Sex Trafficking Awareness Day at the state capitol; and
- 2 for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, sex trafficking is a form of modern day slavery where people profit from the
- 4 control and exploitation of others and is a horrific crime perpetrated against women and
- 5 children; and
- 6 WHEREAS, sex trafficking is one of the fastest growing criminal enterprises in the world,
- 7 and according to the International Labour Organization, profits obtained from commercial
- 8 sexual exploitation are estimated at \$99 billion per year globally; and
- 9 WHEREAS, according to a 2014 study by the Urban Institute, the underground sex industry
- 10 in Atlanta grew from \$238 million to \$290 million from 2003 to 2007, which was a 22
- 11 percent increase; and
- 12 WHEREAS, according to Georgia Cares, the state-wide system of care, more than 1,800
- 13 referrals for exploited and trafficked children have been received since August, 2009; and
- 14 WHEREAS, hundreds of grassroots activists will gather at the state capitol on February 28,
- 15 2017, to raise awareness about the need to end sex trafficking in Georgia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Georgia Cares, Street Grace, the United Way of Greater Atlanta, Out of
- 17 Darkness, Wellspring Living, and City of Refuge have worked together to organize and
- 18 empower tens of thousands of grassroots activists across the State of Georgia to end sex
- 19 trafficking.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 21 the members of this body recognize February 28, 2017, as Sex Trafficking Awareness Day
- 22 at the state capitol.
