3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Homeland Security
- 5 Assessment of Terrorists' Use of Virtual Currencies Act".

1SEC. 2. THREAT ASSESSMENT ON TERRORIST USE OF VIR-2TUAL CURRENCY.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 120 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Under Secretary 4 5 of Homeland Security for Intelligence and Analysis, as authorized by section 201(b)(1) of the Homeland Security 6 7 Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 121(b)(1)), shall, in coordination 8 with appropriate Federal partners, develop and dissemi-9 nate a threat assessment regarding the actual and poten-10 tial threat posed by individuals using virtual currency to 11 carry out activities in furtherance of an act of terrorism, including the provision of material support or resources 12 13 to a foreign terrorist organization. Consistent with the protection of classified and confidential unclassified infor-14 mation, the Under Secretary shall share the threat assess-15 16 ment developed under this section with State, local, and tribal law enforcement officials, including officials who op-17 erate within State, local, and regional fusion centers 18 19 through the Department of Homeland Security State, Local, and Regional Fusion Center Initiative established 20 in section 210A of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 21 (6 U.S.C. 124h). 22

23 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

24 (1) The term "foreign terrorist organization"25 means an organization designated as a foreign ter-
