### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Gold Star Children5 Act".

3	CEASED VETERANS.
4	Section 2108(3) of title 5, United States Code, is

6	(1) in subparagraph (G), by striking "and" at
7	the end;
8	(2) in subparagraph (H), by inserting "and"
9	after the semicolon; and
10	(3) by inserting before the matter following
11	subparagraph (H) the following new subparagraph:
12	"(I) the child (including an adopted child,
13	recognized natural child, stepchild, or foster
14	child) of—
15	"(i) an individual who lost his or her
16	life under honorable conditions while serv-
17	ing in the armed forces during a period
18	named by paragraph (1)(A); or
19	"(ii) a service-connected permanently
20	and totally disabled veteran;".
