## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## **Coast Smart Council – Duties and Authority**

FOR the purpose of altering the duties of the Coast Smart Council to include the development of eligibility criteria, standards, and procedures for categorical exemptions from the application of certain Coast Smart requirements for certain projects under certain circumstances; authorizing the Council to recommend certain regulations for adoption by the Secretary of Natural Resources; and generally relating to the Coast Smart Council.
