Section 1. The following amendment to the

Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and

shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a

majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in

accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution

of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Article VIII of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, now appearing as Section 177 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

"ARTICLE VIII.

"SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS.

"(a) Every Only a citizen of the United States who has attained the age of eighteen years and has resided in this state and in a county thereof for the time provided by law, if registered as provided by law, shall have the right to vote in the county of his or her residence. The Legislature may prescribe reasonable and nondiscriminatory requirements as prerequisites to registration for voting. The Legislature shall, by statute, prescribe a procedure by which eligible citizens can register to vote.

"(b) No person convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude, or who is mentally incompetent, shall be qualified to vote until restoration of civil and political rights or removal of disability.

"(c) The Legislature shall by law provide for the 1 2 registration of voters, absentee voting, secrecy in voting, the administration of elections, and the nomination of 3 candidates." 4 5 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 6 7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 8 9 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 10 state. Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 11 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 12 13 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 14 following description of the substance or subject matter of 15 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 16 Alabama of 1901, to amend Article VIII of the Constitution of 17 18 Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 177 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as 19 20 amended, to provide that only a citizen of the United States 21 has the right to vote. 22 "Proposed by Act ." This description shall be followed by the following 23 24 language: 25 "Yes ( ) No ( )."
