Section 6386(a) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 6386. Mandatory reporting of children under one year of age. 10 When report to be made. -- A health care provider shall 11 immediately make a report or cause a report to be made to the 12 appropriate county agency if the provider is involved in the delivery or care of a child under one year of age who is born 13 and identified as being affected by any of the following: 14 15 (1)Illegal substance abuse by the child's mother. 16 Withdrawal symptoms resulting from prenatal drug

exposure. [unless the child's mother, during the pregnancy,

1	(i) under the care of a prescribing medical
