

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 144

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Jack A. Parton of Sevierville to the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201, provides for the creation of the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(a)(1)(B)(i), provides that the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint a director of schools to the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission; and

WHEREAS, Speaker Beth Harwell acting pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(a)(1)(B)(i), has appointed Jack A. Parton of Sevierville as a member of the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission for a term that commenced August 31, 2018, and expires June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Jack A. Parton has served as Director of Schools for Sevier County Schools since 2000, having previously been elected to the position of Superintendent of the Sevier County school system in September 1988; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(b)(1), provides that each appointed member shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly upon recommendation of the Education Committee of the Senate and the Education Administration and Planning Committee of the House of Representatives; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Jack A. Parton to the State

Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission for a term that commenced August 31, 2018, and expires June 30, 2020.
