A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend Malori Dawn Dupree upon her receipt of a 2017 Women of Excellence Award

Women's Caucus Foundation Scholarship.

big sister to three half-siblings, three step-siblings, and the younger sister to two  
step-siblings; and

WHEREAS, Malori of Gueydan High School exhibited a passion for involvement  
at a very young age as she participated in several honorable programs such as Vermilion  
Parish Government Day and Louisiana Girls State; and

WHEREAS, as a longtime outstanding student, Malori has received multiple

WHEREAS, Malori will be attending McNeese State University in Lake Charles, Louisiana, in the fall of 2017 where she plans to pursue a degree as a registered nurse and in the near future she hopes to pursue her master's degree in RN-Midwifery, with her ultimate goal of owning a birthing center; and
