Alteration of number or mark on pistol or revolver. 29 (1) Any person who changes, alters, removes, or obliterates the name of the maker, the model, manufacturer's number, or other mark of identification, including any distinguishing 30 number or mark assigned by the Department of Public Safety, on any [pistol or revolver] 31 firearm, without first having secured written permission from the Department of Public Safety 32 to make the change, alteration, or removal, is guilty of a [class A misdemeanor] third degree 33 34 felony. (2) Any person who is found in possession of a firearm which has been altered as 35

36 described in Subsection (1) is guilty of a third degree felony.
