A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to modify a regulation regarding the involuntary deplaning or denial of boarding a flight of any passenger on an oversold flight to accommodate a member of the air carrier's flight crew or staff.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hands off Passengers
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NO BUMPING FOR FLIGHT CREW.**

2 The Secretary of Transportation shall modify part
3 250 of title 14, Code of Federal Regulations, to prohibit
4 the involuntary deplaning or denial of boarding a flight
5 of any passenger holding a confirmed reserved seat on an
6 oversold flight to accommodate a member of the air car-
7 rier's flight crew or staff.

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
