A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to modify a regulation regarding the involuntary deplaning or denial of boarding a flight of any passenger on an oversold flight to accommodate a member of the air carrier's flight crew or staff.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hands off Passengers
- 5 Act".

1 SEC. 2. NO BUMPING FOR FLIGHT CREW.

- 2 The Secretary of Transportation shall modify part
- 3 250 of title 14, Code of Federal Regulations, to prohibit
- 4 the involuntary deplaning or denial of boarding a flight
- 5 of any passenger holding a confirmed reserved seat on an
- 6 oversold flight to accommodate a member of the air car-
- 7 rier's flight crew or staff.
