## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 1 of Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to employment of certificated professional personnel in
- 3 elementary and secondary education, so as to give a short title to a Code section relating to
- 4 qualification for certain certificates for military spouses; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Subpart 1 of Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 9 Annotated, relating to employment of certificated professional personnel in elementary and
- 10 secondary education, is amended by revising Code Section 20-2-200.2, relating to
- 11 qualification for certain certificates for military spouses, as follows:
- 12 "20-2-200.2.
- 13 (a) This Code section shall be known and may be cited as the 'Tracy Rainey Act.'
- 14 (a)(b) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Certificate' means a credential issued by the Professional Standards Commission
- certifying the qualifications and classification of an individual and to authorize such
- individual for employment in the public schools of this state.
- 18 (2) 'Military' means the United States armed forces, including the National Guard.
- 19 (3) 'Military spouse' means a spouse of a service member or transitioning service
- member.
- 21 (4) 'Service member' means an active or reserve member of the armed forces, including
- the National Guard.
- 23 (b)(c) No later than July 1, 2018, the Professional Standards Commission shall adopt and
- 24 implement a process by which military spouses may qualify for temporary certificates,
- 25 certificates by endorsement, or expedited certificates upon moving to Georgia with their
- service member or transitioning service member spouse."
