13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – General Provisions

- 17 (a) With advice from the Secretary of Budget and Management and in accordance 18 with § 5–103 of this title, the Ethics Commission shall determine whether an individual in 19 an executive unit is a public official for the purposes of this title.

9 (1) THE SECRETARY OF A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT IN THE 10 EXECUTIVE BRANCH;

11(2) THE PRESIDENT OF A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION12INSTITUTION, AS DEFINED IN § 10–101 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; AND

13 (3) A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2020.
