To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for improvements to the specially adapted housing program of the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ryan Kules Specially" 5 Adaptive Housing Improvement Act of 2019". SEC. 2. PRIORITY IN AWARD OF SPECIALLY ADAPTED HOUS-6 7 ING GRANTS TO SERIOUSLY ILL VETERANS. 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2101 of title 38, United 9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following 10 new subsection: 11 "(d) PRIORITY FOR SERIOUSLY ILL VETERANS.—(1) In providing assistance under this section, the Secretary 12 13 shall give priority to seriously ill veterans. 14 "(2) In this section, the term 'seriously ill veteran' 15 shall have the meaning given such term by the Secretary.". 16 (b) DEFINITION OF SERIOUSLY ILL VETERAN.— 17 (1) IN GENERAL.—By not later than 90 days 18 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-19 retary of Veterans Affairs shall— 20 (A) determine the meaning of the term "se-21 riously ill veteran" for purposes of subsection (d) 22 of section 2101 of title 38, United States Code, 23 as added by subsection (a); and

1	(B) submit to the Committees on Veterans'
2	Affairs of the Senate and House of Representa-
3	tives the meaning of such term as so determined.
4	(2) APPLICABILITY.—The definition of "seriously
5	ill veteran" as determined under paragraph (1) shall
6	apply for purposes of such subsection (d) beginning
7	on the date that is 30 days after the date on which
8	the Secretary submits to the Committees on Veterans'
9	Affairs of the Senate and House of Representatives the
10	definition of such term as so determined.
11	(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by sub-
12	section (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2020, and apply
13	with respect to assistance provided on or after that date.

(c) INCREASE IN MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE
FOR ADAPTATION TO VETERAN'S RESIDENCE.—Section
24 2102(b)(2) of such title is amended by striking "\$12,000"
25 and inserting "\$19,733".

(d) INCREASE IN AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE
 FOR ACQUISITION OF HOUSING WITH SPECIAL FEA TURES.—Section 2102(d)(1) of such title is amended by
 striking "\$63,780" and inserting "\$98,492".

5 (e) INCREASE IN AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE
6 FOR ADAPTATIONS TO VETERANS' RESIDENCES.—Section
7 2102(d)(2) of such title is amended by striking "\$12,756"
8 and inserting "\$19,733".

9 (f) EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION.—The amend-10 ments made by this section shall take effect on October 1, 11 2020. The amendments made by subsections (c) and (d) 12 shall apply with respect to individuals who have not re-13 ceived the maximum amount of assistance under section 14 2101 of title 38, United States Code, before such date.

receive an additional amount of assistance under subsection
(a) or (b) of section 2101 of this title in an amount that

(d).

24 "(C) With respect to an educational institution that25 did not participate in the work-study program under this

section during the academic year beginning August 1, 2018,
 the Secretary shall determine the annual amount to provide
 to the educational institution under subparagraph (A) as
 follows:

5 "(i) For the first academic year in which the 6 educational institution participates in the work-study 7 program beginning on or after August 1, 2020, the 8 amount shall be an amount the Secretary determines 9 appropriate based on amounts provided to similar 10 educational institutions pursuant to subparagraph 11 (B).

12 *"(ii)* Except as provided by subparagraph 13 (D)(ii), for each academic year occurring after the 14 academic year specified in clause (i), the amount 15 shall be the total amount the educational institution paid under this section for work-study allowance to 16 17 individuals enrolled at such educational institution 18 during the previous academic year in which individ-19 uals enrolled at such educational institution partici-20 pated in the work-study program.

21 "(D)(i) Except as provided in clause (ii), if the Sec22 retary provides an annual amount to an educational insti23 tution under subparagraph (B) or (C) that is more than
24 the total amount the educational institution pays to indi25 viduals under paragraph (1), the educational institution

shall return to the Secretary the unpaid amount and the
 Secretary shall transfer such amount into the general fund
 of the Treasury.

4 "(*ii*) If the annual amount provided to an educational 5 institution under subparagraph (B) or (C) is more, but less than 25 percent more, than the total amount the edu-6 7 cational institution pays to individuals under paragraph 8 (1), and the educational institution plans to participate in 9 the work-study program under this section during the subsequent academic year, the educational institution may re-10 tain the amount of the overpayment if the educational insti-11 tution notifies the Secretary of the amount of the overpay-12 ment and the intention of the educational institution to re-13 tain such amount. Any amount retained by an educational 14 15 institution under this clause may only be used by the educational institution to provide work-study allowance to in-16 17 dividuals enrolled at the educational institution.

"(iii) At any time an educational institution may request the Secretary to increase the annual amount that the
Secretary provides the educational institution under subparagraph (B) or (C).

(E) Pursuant to section 3690(c), section 3693, and
other provisions of chapter 36 of this title, the Secretary
shall ensure that educational institutions carry out the

1 work-study allowance program in compliance with this section.". 2

22 "(11) An individual who is the child or spouse 23 of a member of the Selected Reserve who dies on or 24 after September 11, 2001—

1	"(A) from a service-connected disability;

5	from active duty or active duty for training.".

1SEC. 7. TREATMENT OF CERTAIN PREPARATORY COURSES2AS PROGRAMS OF EDUCATION FOR PUR-3POSES OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-4FAIRS EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PRO-5GRAMS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 33 of title 38, United
7 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 3315A
8 the following new section:

9 "§3315B. Preparatory courses for licensure, certifi-10 cation, or national tests

11 "(a) IN GENERAL.—An individual entitled to edu-12 cational assistance under this chapter shall also be entitled 13 to payment for a preparatory course for a licensing or cer-14 tification test that is required or used to enter into, main-15 tain, or advance in employment in a predetermined and 16 identified vocation or profession.

17 "(b) AMOUNT.—The amount of educational assistance
18 payable under this chapter for a course described in sub19 section (a) is the lesser of—

20 "(1) the fee charged for the course; or

21 "(2) the amount of entitlement available to the
22 individual under this chapter at the time of payment
23 for the course under this section.

24 "(c) CHARGE AGAINST ENTITLEMENT.—The number
25 of months of entitlement charged an individual under this
26 chapter for a course described in subsection (a) shall be pro-

rated based on the actual amount of the fee charged for the
 course relative to the rate for 1 month payable—

3 "(1) for the academic year beginning on August
4 1, 2020, \$1,460; or

5 "(2) for an academic year beginning on any sub6 sequent August 1, the amount for the previous aca7 demic year beginning on August 1 under this sub8 section, as increased by the percentage increase equal
9 to the most recent percentage increase determined
10 under section 3015(h).".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections at
the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting after
the item relating to section 3315A the following new item:
"3315B. Preparatory courses for licensure, certification, or national tests.".
