A BILL

To ensure Transportation Security Administration employees who contract COVID–19 are entitled to appropriate workers’ compensation and other benefits, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coronavirus Workers’
5 Compensation for TSA Employees Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR TSA EMPLOYEES**
2 **WHO CONTRACT COVID-19.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any Transportation Security Ad-
4 ministration employee described in subsection (b) who is
5 diagnosed with COVID-19 during the period between
6 January 30, 2020, and January 30, 2022, shall, upon ap-
7 plication, presumptively be entitled to disability compensa-
8 tion, medical services, and any other benefit provided
9 under subchapter I of chapter 81 of title 5, United States
10 Code.

11 (b) TSA EMPLOYEE.—A Transportation Security
12 Administration employee described in this subsection is
13 any of the following:

- 14 (1) A transportation security officer.
15 (2) A Federal air marshal.
16 (3) A canine handler.
17 (4) Any employee carrying out duties that re-
18 quire substantial contact with the public.

19 (c) ATTORNEYS' FEES.—The Secretary of Labor
20 shall approve any claim of reasonable legal or other serv-
21 ices furnished with respect to a case, claim, or award for
22 any Transportation Security Administration employee
23 under this section.
