SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 102

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE BOARD
OF VETERINARY MEDICINE RELATING TO RULES OF THE STATE OF IDAHO BOARD OF
VETERINARY MEDICINE.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
islative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
Board of Veterinary Medicine relating to Rules of the State of Idaho Board of
Veterinary Medicine are not consistent with legislative intent and should be
rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
sion of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Rep-
resentatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 46.01.01, Board of Veterinary
Medicine, Rules of the State of Idaho Board of Veterinary Medicine, Section
014., Subsection 02.f., only, adopted as a pending fee rule under Docket Num-
ber 46-0101-1603, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void
and of no force and effect.
