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Charles County - Board of Education - Membership Alterations

FOR the purpose of altering the manner of election for certain members of the Charles County Board of Education by specifying that certain members be elected from certain school board county commissioner districts; requiring the Board of Charles County Commissioners to establish a certain number of school board districts in a certain manner; providing for the ballot requirements for a certain election; requiring the State Board of Elections declare the election of certain candidates; providing for the qualifications of the elected members of the county board; altering the day the term of an elected member begins: establishing staggered terms for the elected members of the county board beginning with a certain election; prohibiting elected members from serving more than a certain number of consecutive terms; requiring the County Commissioners to fill a certain vacancy under certain eircumstances; establishing a residency requirement for an individual appointed to fill a certain vacancy; requiring the County Commissioners to interview an applicant

- 25 (2) the <u>members member</u> elected from school board districts 2, 4, and 6 the county at–large at the general election in November 2022, shall serve for a term of 2 years until a successor is elected and qualifies.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
