## A BILL

To extend certain provisions of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act until September 30, 2030, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Extension of the Carib-
- 5 bean Basin Economic Recovery Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE CARIBBEAN BASIN ECONOMIC
- 7 RECOVERY ACT.
- 8 Section 213 of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recov-
- 9 ery Act (19 U.S.C. 2703) is amended as follows:

10	TO CERTAIN OTHER APPAREL ARTICLES.—In clause
11	(iv)(II) of such subsection, by striking "18" and in-
12	serting "28".
13	(3) Extension of transition period.—In
14	subsection (b)(5)(D)(i), by striking "September 30,
15	2020" and inserting "September 30, 2030".
