A BILL

Making appropriations for the salaries and expenses of certain U.S. Bureau of Prison employees working during a Federal Government shutdown, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keep our Correctional
5 Officers Paid Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF CERTAIN BUREAU OF**
2 **PRISONS EMPLOYEES WORKING DURING A**
3 **FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN.**

4 Out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise ap-
5 propriated, there is appropriated such sums as are nec-
6 essary to pay, during any period of a lapse in discretionary
7 appropriations during any fiscal year beginning on or after
8 the date of the enactment of this section, the salaries and
9 expenses of any correctional staff of the Bureau of Prisons
10 excepted from furlough during such lapse.

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
