# 1 AN ACT concerning

# Public Utilities – Termination of Service to Multifamily Dwelling Unit Notification to Property Owner or Property Manager

# FOR the purpose of requiring a public service company that is going to terminate electric or gas service to a certain customer to notify a certain property owner or property manager before terminating service; requiring a public service company to provide the notice only to certain persons under certain circumstances; providing for the construction of this Act; requiring the Public Service Commission to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to termination of electric or gas service.

(A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, IF A PUBLIC SERVICE
 COMPANY IS GOING TO TERMINATE ELECTRIC OR GAS SERVICE TO A CUSTOMER WHO
 RESIDES IN A MULTIFAMILY DWELLING UNIT, THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY SHALL
 NOTIFY THE PROPERTY OWNER OR PROPERTY MANAGER OF THE MULTIFAMILY
 DWELLING UNIT BEFORE TERMINATING SERVICE TO THE CUSTOMER.

1 (B) A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY MAY ONLY PROVIDE NOTICE OF 2 TERMINATION UNDER THIS SECTION TO A PROPERTY OWNER OR PROPERTY 3 MANAGER WHO ENROLLS IN A SERVICE TERMINATION NOTIFICATION PROGRAM 4 ESTABLISHED UNDER REGULATIONS THAT THE COMMISSION ADOPTS.

5 (C) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE CONSTRUED TO PREVENT ANY 6 OTHER FORM OF THIRD–PARTY NOTIFICATION THAT A CUSTOMER MAY REQUEST.

7 (D) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 8 SECTION.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2017.
