A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 1 of Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to certificated professional personnel, so as to provide for the
- 3 establishment of a process by the Professional Standards Commission by which military
- 4 spouses may qualify for temporary certificates, certificates by endorsement, or expedited
- 5 certificates upon moving to Georgia with their service member or transitioning service
- 6 member spouse; to provide for definitions; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 7 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

- 10 Subpart 1 of Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated, relating to certificated professional personnel, is amended by adding a new Code
- 12 section to read as follows:
- 13 "<u>20-2-200.2.</u>
- 14 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Certificate' means a credential issued by the Professional Standards Commission
- certifying the qualifications and classification of an individual and to authorize such
- individual for employment in the public schools of this state.
- (2) 'Military' means the United States armed forces, including the National Guard.
- 19 (3) 'Military spouse' means a spouse of a service member or transitioning service
- 20 <u>member.</u>
- 21 (4) 'Service member' means an active or reserve member of the armed forces, including
- the National Guard.
- 23 (b) No later than July 1, 2018, the Professional Standards Commission shall adopt and
- 24 <u>implement a process by which military spouses may qualify for temporary certificates,</u>
- 25 <u>certificates by endorsement, or expedited certificates upon moving to Georgia with their</u>
- 26 <u>service member or transitioning service member spouse."</u>
