3 SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE A WIG
4 AND TREAT TRACTION ALOPECIA UNDER THE

5 TRICARE PROGRAM.

6 (a) EXPANSION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE A
7 WIG.—Section 1074c of title 10, United States Code, is

amended by inserting "traction alopecia or" before "alope cia".

3 (b) TREATMENT OF TRACTION ALOPECIA.—Section
4 1074d(b) of such title is amended by adding at the end
5 the following new paragraph:

6 "(9) Traction alopecia.".

7 (c) REGULATIONS.—Not later than September 30, 8 2024, the Secretary concerned shall prescribe regulations 9 regarding grooming standards and training materials to 10 ensure that members of the Armed Forces are warned that 11 the prolonged use of tightly gathered hairstyles, dyes, and 12 chemical hair products may cause health issues, including 13 traction alopecia.
