2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

3 → Section 1. KRS 156.029 is amended to read as follows:

eleven (11) members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate and the House of Representatives] of the General Assembly, one (1) person currently employed as an elementary or secondary public school teacher appointed by the Governor to serve as a nonvoting member, and [with] the president of the Council on Postsecondary Education and the Secretary of the Education and Workforce Cabinet serving as [an] ex officio nonvoting members [members]. Of the voting members, seven (7) members shall represent each of the Supreme Court districts as established by KRS 21A.010, and four (4) members shall represent the state at large. Each of the appointed members shall serve for a four (4) year term f. except the initial appointments shall be as follows: the seven (7) members representing Supreme Court districts shall serve a term which shall expire on April 14, 1994; and the four (4) at-large members shall serve a term which shall expire on April 14, 1992. Subsequent Appointments shall be submitted to the Senate and to the House of Representatives for confirmation in accordance with KRS 11.160. Each appointment by the Governor shall be agreed upon by both chambers in order for the person to be confirmed. Each confirmed appointee shall take office on April 15]. Appointments of the voting members shall be made without reference to (2) occupation, political affiliation, or similar consideration and shall ensure broad geographic, racial, and gender diversity among members. No voting member at the time of his *or her* appointment or during the term of his *or her* service shall be

- 3 In the event that the General Assembly is not in session at the time of the
- 4 appointment, the consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives shall be
- 5 obtained during the time the General Assembly next convenes.
- 6 (4) At the first regular meeting of the board in each fiscal year, a chairperson shall be 7 elected from its voting membership.
- 8 The members shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the (5) 9 performance of their duties.
