### A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to modernize provisions relating to rural health clinics under Medicare.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Rural Health Clinic

5 Burden Reduction Act".

6 SEC. 2. MODERNIZING PHYSICIAN, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT,

## AND NURSE PRACTITIONER UTILIZATION REQUIREMENTS.

9 Section 1861(aa) of the Social Security Act (42
10 U.S.C. 1395x(aa)) is amended—

(1) in paragraph (2)(B), by striking "has an
 arrangement" and all that follows through the first
 semicolon and inserting "meets the requirements de scribed in paragraph (8);"; and

5 (2) by adding at the end the following new6 paragraph:

7 "(8) REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN FACILITIES DE8 SCRIBED.—For purposes of paragraph (2)(B), with re9 spect to a facility which is not a physician-directed clinic,
10 the following requirements are described in this para11 graph:

"(A) ARRANGEMENT.—The facility has an arrangement consistent with the provisions of State
and local law relative to the practice, performance,
and delivery of health services, with one or more
physician assistants (as defined in paragraph
(5)(A)) or one or more nurse practitioners (as defined in such paragraph).

19 "(B) PRACTICE AND OVERSIGHT REQUIRE20 MENTS.—The delivery of health services under such
21 arrangement shall be in accordance with State law
22 or the State regulatory mechanism governing the
23 practice of physician assistants or nurse practi24 tioners.".

Section 1861(aa)(2)(G) of the Social Security Act
(42 U.S.C. 1395x(aa)(2)(G)) is amended by striking ",
including clinical laboratory services" and all that follows
through "additional diagnostic services" and inserting the
following: "and has prompt access to clinical laboratory
services and additional diagnostic services".

# 9 SEC. 4. ALLOWING RURAL HEALTH CLINICS THE FLEXI10 BILITY TO CONTRACT WITH PHYSICIAN AS11 SISTANTS AND NURSE PRACTITIONERS.

Section 1861(aa) of the Social Security Act (42
U.S.C. 1395x(aa)), in the first sentence of the flush matter following paragraph (2), is amended by inserting "or
contracts with" after "(iii) employs".

### 16 SEC. 5. URBANIZED AREA FIX.

17 Section 1861(aa) of the Social Security Act (42 18 U.S.C. 1395x(aa)), in the first sentence of the flush mat-19 ter following paragraph (2), is amended by striking "(i) 20 is located in an area that is not an urbanized area" and 21 inserting "(i) is located in an area that is not in an urban 22 area of 50,000 or more".

### 23 SEC. 6. EXCEPTION TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH LIMITATION.

24 Section 1861(aa) of the Social Security Act (42
25 U.S.C. 1395x(aa)), in the first sentence of the flush mat26 ter following paragraph (2), is amended by inserting the
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following before the period: ", except in the case where
 the facility is located in an area that is designated (under
 section 332(a)(1)(A) of the Public Health Service Act) as
 a mental health professional shortage area".

### 5 SEC. 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall7 take effect on January 1, 2024, and shall apply to items8 and services furnished on or after such date.

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
