Senators Unterman of the 45th and Heath of the 31st offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend Senate Committee on Education and Youth substitute to SR 95 (LC 33 6843S) by*
2 *deleting line 24 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*
3 of the county voting in a referendum thereon, provided that any independent school district
4 has the option by resolution thereof to exclude itself from any such referendum, and if such
5 option is exercised, no such tax shall be collected by the county school board within the
6 limits of such independent school district. Further, if such county-wide referendum fails or
7 an independent school district exercises its right to be excluded therefrom, each such
8 independent school district is authorized to call for a referendum to impose, levy, and collect
9 a sales and use tax for educational purposes within the limits of such independent school
10 district conditioned upon approval by a majority of the qualified voters residing within the
11 limits of the independent school district voting in a referendum thereon. This tax shall be at
12 the rate of 1 percent and

13 *By inserting after "tax" on line 32 "collected from a county-wide tax".*

14 *By deleting the quotation mark at the end of line 39 and inserting: "The net proceeds of any*
15 *tax levied solely by an independent school district shall be retained by and used solely by*
16 *such district."*
