A BILL

To amend title 14, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of the department in which the Coast Guard is operating, in coordination with the Secretary of Education, to establish programs for the purpose of improving the mathematics and scientific knowledge and skills of elementary and secondary school students and faculty members, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Coast Guard Youth
- 3 STEM Programs Expansion Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. SUPPORT OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDU-
- 5 CATION IN SCIENCE, MATHEMATICS, AND
- 6 TECHNOLOGY.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 7 of title 14, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 9 lowing:
- 10 "§ 719. Support of elementary and secondary edu-
- cation in science, mathematics, and tech-
- 12 **nology**
- 13 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the department
- 14 in which the Coast Guard is operating, in coordination
- 15 with the Secretary of Education, may establish programs
- 16 for the purpose of improving the mathematics and sci-
- 17 entific knowledge and skills of elementary and secondary
- 18 school students and faculty members.
- 19 "(b) Cooperation With Department of De-
- 20 FENSE.—The Secretary of the department in which the
- 21 Coast Guard is operating may cooperate and coordinate
- 22 with the Secretary of Defense for the purpose of improving
- 23 the mathematics and scientific knowledge and skills of ele-
- 24 mentary school students and faculty members, including
- 25 participating in the Department of Defense STARBASE

- 1 Program under section 2193b of title 10, United States
- 2 Code.
- 3 "(c) Areas of Focus.—In addition to general math-
- 4 ematics and scientific knowledge, any program or activity
- 5 carried out under subsection (a) or (b) may also focus on
- 6 areas of specific Coast Guard expertise, including lim-
- 7 nology, marine science, and oceanography.".
- 8 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis at the be-
- 9 ginning of such chapter is amended by adding at the end
- 10 the following new item:

"719. Support of elementary and secondary education in science, mathematics, and technology.".
